Painting life

The exhibition begins with *Painting Life*, a title that sums up in just two words and artistic purpose of more than thirty years, with a growing international projection. From Spain to Los Angeles, from Lisbon to Melbourne via Madrid and Barcelona, her place of residence. Eva Armisen continues to tell us in her own words that she paints life.

This section groups together a series of paintings in which we sense the profound meaning that painting holds for the artist, to connect with what she feels and to transmit feelings, and emotions.

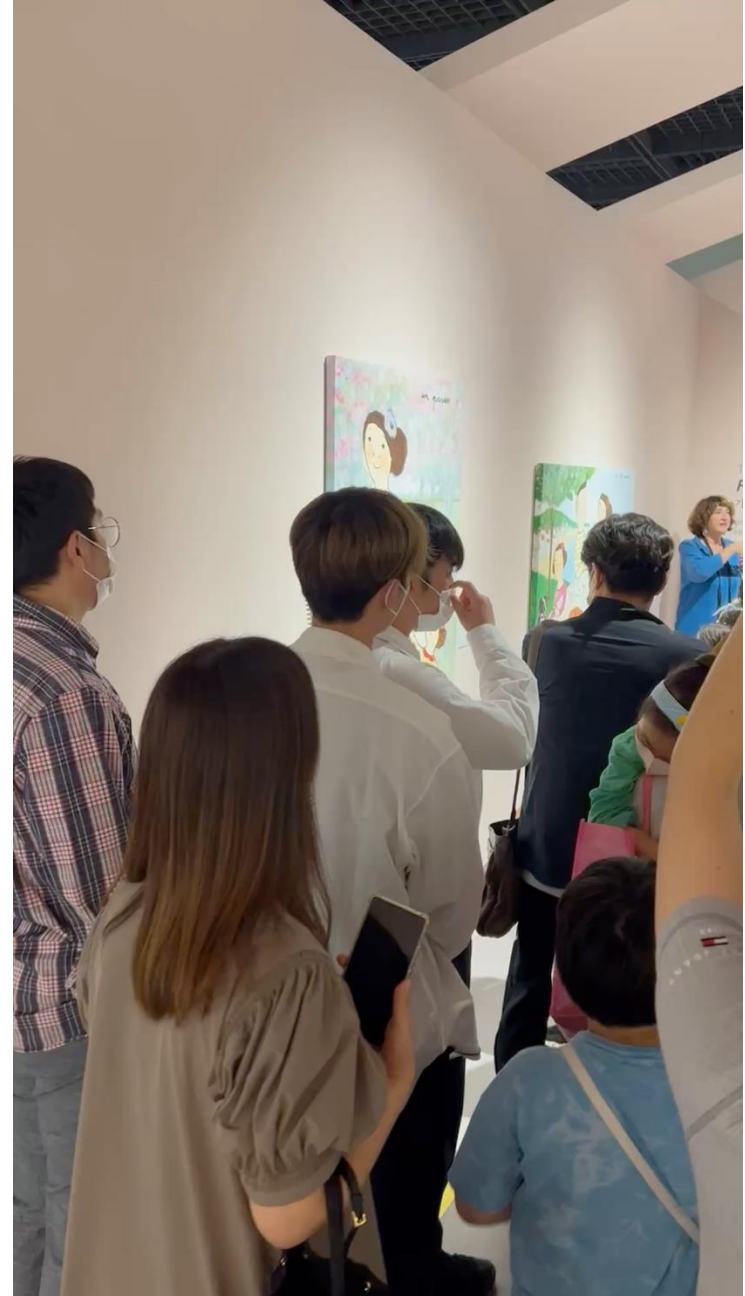
The extraordinariness of everyday life

Love

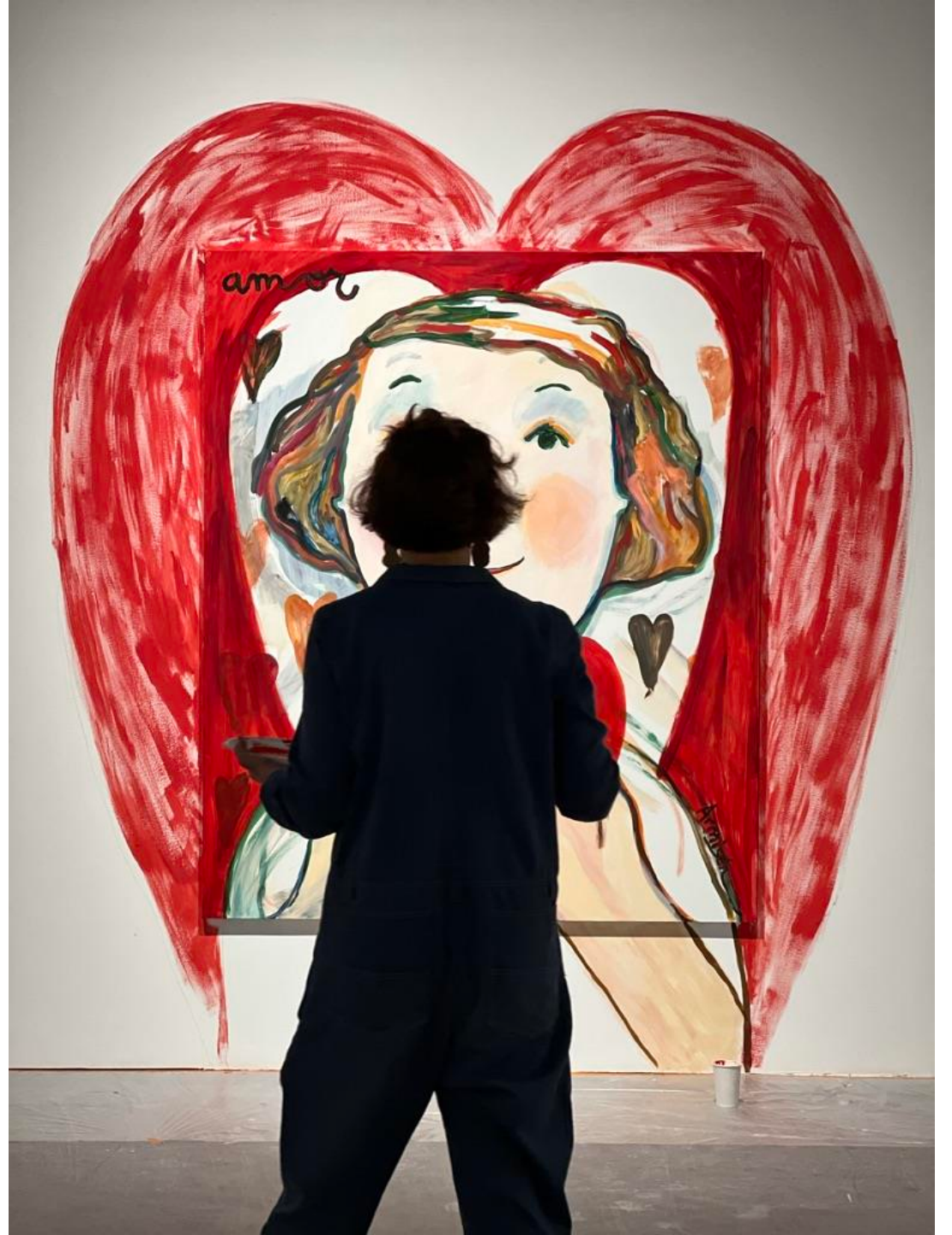
The essence of art, as the artist sees it, begins with love.

Love becomes a central chapter in this exhibition, where her work unfolds the many feelings, gestures, and connections that love brings to life. Through tender and vibrant pieces, Armisén invites us to nurture our hearts and find harmony, reminding us that love has the power to build and unmake, to steady and transform.

In this section, love appears in all its forms—changing with time, growing with age, and shaping the rhythm of our days. It is in the act of giving and receiving, in the beating of hearts, that her art finds its pulse.







Naturaleza / Nature

Nature holds a profound presence in the work of Armisén, serving as both a source of inspiration and a backdrop to the emotions and stories she portrays. Her art captures the quiet beauty of natural elements—Eva highlights the harmony between humanity and nature, celebrating its cycles, vitality, and enduring presence in our lives.

Her work reminds us to slow down, to notice the details, and to find joy and solace in the landscapes that surround us, making nature an integral part of her artistic language and a reflection of life's interconnectedness.







Vida / Life

In these four paintings, Eva Armisen harnesses the power of scale to convey a deep, emotional resonance between the individual and the external world. The large size of the canvases creates a compelling presence, symbolizing the strength and determination of the individual in the face of life's challenges.

By enlarging the scale, Armisen emphasizes the inner force that drives her characters, portraying the emotional and psychological fight against external forces. The physicality of the paintings amplifies the intensity of the emotions they express, making the viewer feel the tension and resilience within. This deliberate use of size reveals not just the external struggles, but also the profound inner strength that sustains us through them.



La lucha y la fragilidad / Fragility and Strength

In Eva Armisen's work, beneath the bold use of color, a tenderness reflects life's fragility. In the *Strength and Fragility* section, courage is paired with self-will.

Strength is represented by bold oil paintings on linen, large scale, and straight strokes brushes embody resilience and determination.

In contrast, the ceramics, fragile by nature, symbolize the vulnerability at the heart of this struggle. Each head, a unique piece created for the exhibition, expresses different reflections: a butterfly for transformation, freedom of thought, and the ocean as a sanctuary. The fragile medium of ceramics highlights the delicate balance between strength and fragility, where vulnerability is as essential as resilience.





Celebración / Celebration

Eva Armisen has been called the "painter of happiness."

In the exhibition's final section, **Celebration**, life is portrayed as a vibrant party—filled with vibrant colors, fireworks, dances, shared moments of leisure, delightful traditions, and longed-for encounters. The artist channels the words of Rubén Darío, reminding us that everything depends on the color of the glass through which we see the world.

The *Celebration* section concludes the exhibition, embodying Eva Armisen's wish for viewers to leave with a lasting sense of joy.





La plaza

At the heart of the exhibition lies *La Plaza*, a space designed by Armisén to evoke the essence of a small-town square. Visitors are invited to play around and relax. This is Eva's head, a space that reflects her world—welcoming, vibrant, and full of life. Here, you can relax, take photos, enjoy the view, being part of it and experience the joy that defines her art.

Her art speaks to universal emotions and experiences, making it deeply relatable across cultures. In Taiwan, her focus on themes such as family, nature, and the celebration of everyday moments finds a natural connection with the island's traditions and values. Taiwanese culture emphasizes the importance of close-knit family ties, a love for community gatherings, and a deep reverence for the natural world—values central to Eva's creative universe.
